#### **ADMISSION PROCEDURE IN SP SMART SCHOOLS**

#### **Steps for Admission Procedure:**

- 1) **REGISTRATION PROCESS:** First step in admission process is 'Registration'of your ward for the admission process. The parent is required to fill in the form for registration on school website www.spsmartschools.com/admissions. The parent need to bring in required documents like marks card of last class, aadhaar card, RR Card (in case of admission to class 10th, 11th & 12th).
- 2) **ADMISSION ENTRANCE TEST:** After the registration of the ward is complete. A date for admission entrance test is provided to student along with the syllabus for the test. A student need to appear in the test on the provided date.
- 3) **RESULT ANNOUNCED:** Result of the admission entrance test in done 2-3 days from the date of test. The result of the test is displayed at campus where the test is conducted. Eligible students are informed about their result in the test.
- 4) **INTERACTION OF STUDENT:** After the result of the entrance test is conducted, the eligible candidates are informed and are called for interaction with the admission executives.
- 5) **OFFER LETTER FOR ADMISSION ISSUED:** After the entrance exam and interaction with the student is completed, an offer letter is issued to the student to take admission in the school.
- 6) PARENT APPROACHES WITH OFFER LETTER: In this step, parents approach school front office with offer letter for admission of his/her ward in the school.
- 7) **PROVISIONAL / ADMISSION FORM IS FILLED:** After the issuance of offer letter for admission, the admission executives fill up the form of student to enroll student provisionally to the school. All details are filled in the form after confirming from the documents of students.
- 8) PARENT COMPLETES DOCUMENTATION: In this step, parent completes the documentation of the student like Transfer certificate from previous school, Migration certificate (In case of shifting from CBSE), Marks card etc. If any document is remains pending, the admission is considered provisional and gets confirmed only on the submission of all the documents. Note: School is not responsible if JKBOSE takes any action against student because of the absence of any document to be provided by parents of the ward.
- 9) **PARENT DEPOSITS FEE CHARGES:** After the filling up of form and submission of the documents, parents need to deposit fees and charges as per the fee information slip provided.
- 10) **ADMISSION IS CONFIRMED:** Admission is deemed to be confirmed only if all the required documents are deposited to the school until the admission is deemed to be provisional only.

### TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SP SMART SCHOOLS

- 1. The students who are enrolled with inst. will have to work hard regularly. In case, if the teachers feel that the student is not working hard, creating indiscipline in the class, school bus, irregular in attendance, not responding properly, he/she may be expelled from the school. The decision of the Head of the school in this regard will be final and binding on the student. No fee or part of the fee will be refunded in any case.
- 2. If any student absents himself/herself for more than six days continuously without any prior written application. He/she will not be allowed to appear in the class tests and will not be given any test paper(s) and CCE exam, he/she may be deemed to be expelled from the school. - 4. If any student/parents insist on lump sum payment of fee, the school can accept the fee in lump sum also. The refund policy for such students will be applicable as mentioned for students who pay the fee in installments.
- 5. It is for the student himself or herself to see whether he/she is eligible for a particular examination or not. The inst. Doesn't hold itself responsible if a student's admission form cannot be forwarded or is rejected by the examining body on any ground whatsoever. Such a student cannot claim a refund of the whole or any part of the fee he/she has paid to the school.
- 6. Incomplete form will be rejected, it is compulsory to attach required documents and a recent passport size photograph with the admission form. The school reserves the right to use the photograph for publicity in case the student secures position/success in entrance exams. The students should also staple three passport size photographs along with the form.
- 7. The parents can meet the coordinator for any enquiry about their ward's progress or any other problem concerning their ward with the prior appointment only.
- 8. Any student caught adopting unfair practice during the admission cum scholarship test is liable for immediate removal from the examination hall and no refund of admission cum scholarship test fee paid shall be made.
- 9. A student after qualifying admission cum scholarship test and taking admission at school will be bound by the rules and regulations of the school.
- 10. Any change of address/contact no. should be notified in writing to the office within 7-10 days.
- 11. A student who is late for classes/tests will not be allowed to enter the classroom.
- 12. Any study material given during the classes or otherwise shall not be given to those students who are absent without prior application from the parents. No request/personal appointments in this regard shall be entertained.
- 13. Each student will be issued an identity card. The entry into classes/school will be only with identity card. If the identity card of a student i.e. lost/misplaced, a duplicate I-card can be asked from the school against payment of rupees 100. If any student is found misusing the I-card he/she will be rusticated from the school.
- 14. If the study material provided to the student is lost or misplaced, a duplicate set of the books can be obtained from the inst. Against the payment.
- 15. If the bag provided to the student is lost or misplaced, a new bag can be obtained from the school against the payment as per the cost of bag.
- 16. It is compulsory/mandatory to provide email id/mobile no. of the Mother/father/guardian. The result of test or any other information by the school will be sent to the student on email id/postal address. Institution should not be held responsible if any information regarding result or anything else is not received by the student if he/she has not given his/her email id/Address/phone numbers etc. in the admission form at the time of admission.
- 17. If any type of mishap occurs in the premises of school because of situations beyond control or any natural calamity of any type such as earth quakes, floods. Fire, electric short circuit, Terrorist activity etc. the inst. Shall not be responsible in any manner, whatsoever.
- 18. In case if any parent/guardian misbehaves with any staff member of the school, his/her ward can be rusticated from the school and no claim of refund of such student will be entertained. The decision of the school will be final and binding on the student and parent/guardian.
- 19. Use of mobile phones/iPods/motor bikes/cars or any other gadget is strictly prohibited inside and outside the school premises.
- 20. SP Higher Secondary School reserves its right to make any alteration in its programs/venue/timing and days of classes without any prior notice to anybody. The decision of the CEO will be final and binding on the students and parents.
- 21. Documents of any student pending if any at the time of admission are to be submitted within one month after admission date falling which the provisional admission of the student shall will be cancelled and the parent will himself responsible for consequences arose thereof.
- 22. In case of any dispute or differences between you and school regarding the interpretation of these terms and conditions, nonpayment of any claim or any dispute arising out of or in post of these terms and conditions, the same shall be referred to sole arbitrator who shall be appointed by SP Educational trust. The proceedings shall be conducted at Jammu under the provisions of arbitrations & conciliation Act and the courts at Jammu only shall have the jurisdiction over the matter and/or for enforcement as the case may be. If any arbitrator to whom the matter is referred refuses to act or for any reason, doesn't enter the references or enter into the references proceedings or abundant or kept in abeyance or not proceeded with, it shall be lawful for SP educational trust to appoint another person to act as
